

The Borough of New Eagle Council met in an executive session from 6pm to 7pm on Tuesday February 5, 2019 to discuss personnel issues regarding the Public Works Department.

The New Eagle Borough Council met on Tuesday February 6, 2019 at 7pm in the Council Chambers, Municipal Building, 157 Main Street, New Eagle, PA 15067.

The meeting was called to order by President J. Fine, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, roll call was taken by Secretary Kimberly Koontz.

There being a quorum present the meeting was called to order.

Mr. Richardson presented photos to Council of water that is laying in his back yard. He is requesting a possible French drain be placed in the area to prevent the water from flooding his back yard. J. Fine said we will investigate where a French drain can be installed.

Borough Secretary Kimberly Koontz reported on the New Eagle Borough Non-Uniform Pension Plan and Police Pension Plan Audit from January 2014 through December 2017. Both audits are being administered in compliance.

Minutes from the January 2, 2019 were presented to Council for approval. Motion was made by B. Williams and seconded by A. Casebar. Motion was carried by unanimous call of the roll by the Secretary.

Bills in the amount of \$54,221.93 (Bill list A \$39,691.75, Bill list B \$14,530.18) were presented to Council for approval. Motion was made by G. Tirpak and seconded by A. Casebar. Motion was carried by unanimous call of the roll by the Secretary.


The Public Works report for the month of January was reported by A. Casebar. Loader steps that were rotted out were replaced. Both Borough dump trucks were cleaned. Loader was painted. The back hoe had a hose replaced that had blown off. Oil was cleaned off the garage floor and the back hoe. The mine sidewalks were cleared of snow. Christmas decorations were taken down. Roads were salted.

Mayor C. Fine reported that there were vehicles in the Borough that were tagged for inspection and registration being expired.

No further business was discussed, motion to adjourn at 7:20 pm was made by A. Casebar and seconded by B. Williams. Motion was carried by unanimous call of the roll by the Secretary.
