

The Borough of New Eagle Council met on Tuesday June 4, 2019 at 7 pm in the Council Chambers, Municipal Building. 157 Main Street, New Eagle, PA 15067.

The meeting was called to order by President J. Fine, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, roll call was taken by Secretary Kimberly Koontz.

Visitor Richard Charlton of 433 First Ave thanked Mayor C. Fine for cutting the lot next to his residence. He has been getting rodents inside his home due to the overgrowth on the property. He is requesting it be cut at least twice a month. It was explained to Mr. Charlton that the property is not the responsibility of the Borough. Solicitor T. Berggren will research who is the property owner.

A thank you letter from The Monongahela Chamber of Commerce was read by the Secretary thanking Council for their donation to the July 4<sup>th</sup> Fireworks celebration.

Motion to approve the minutes from the May 7, 2019 meeting was made by A. Casebar and seconded by B. Williams. Motion was carried by unanimous call of the roll by the Secretary.

Motion to approve bills in the amount of \$25,881.67 (bill list A \$21,230.94, bill list B \$4650.73) was made by B. Williams and seconded by A. Casebar. Motion was carried by unanimous call of the roll by the Secretary.

Report on Borough Property was given by A. Casebar. Windows are going to be replaced at the Borough Building sometime this month. Painting will begin in early July.

Public Works report was given by Foreman J. Miller. Several signs inside the Borough have been replaced and repaired. Main Street weeds are in the process of being removed. Exterior of the Public Works garage has been cleaned up. Grass cutting continues a weekly basis.

Mayor C. Fine reported that he continues with the grass citations. The website for the Borough is currently having problems. We are currently working to get this resolved.

Police Chief K. Harris said the stop sign on Center and Maple was monitored by Officer Fusco and no citations were issued. Several citations were issued on Union Street.

New Business: Proposed Streets for 2019 paving season was discussed. 4<sup>th</sup> Ave from Sycamore to Wood Street. Maple Ave from Center to Madison. 4<sup>th</sup> Ave from Rt.88 to Neville Street.

No further business was discussed. Motion to adjourn at 7:25 was made by A. Casebar and seconded by B. Williams. Motion was carried by unanimous call of the roll by the Secretary.
