ORDINANCE NO. 522

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW EAGLE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REVISING AND AMENDING THE ORDINANCE FOUND AND EXISTING IN CHAPTER IV, PUBLIC HEALTH, ARTICLE 1 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW EAGLE, PENNSYLVANIA PERTAINING TO GARBAGE, RUBBISH AND REFUSE DUMPING AND REMOVAL IN THE BOROUGH.

Council for the Borough of New Eagle, Washington County, Pennsylvania hereby ordains as follows:

Chapter IV, Public Health, Article 1 of the Ordinances of the Borough of New Eagle, Washington County, Pennsylvania, as amended, pertaining to Garbage, Rubbish and Refuse dumping and removal in the Borough of New Eagle is hereby revised and amended as follows:

1. Every provision of the existing Ordinance, as amended, that references the Borough Street Commissioner is hereby amended to now state Borough Council President, Borough Mayor or their designees.

2. Subsection E, paragraph 3 pertaining to the enforcement of fees for refuse collection is hereby amended to now include a second paragraph stating as follows:

In the event that the Borough shall choose to proceed in any manner provided by law for the collection of municipal claims, and as authorized under 53 P.S. §7101 *et seq.*, the Borough shall file a municipal lien against the property where the refuse removal services were provided, regardless of who resided at the property at the time that the refuse services were provided. Such liens shall include all costs and legal fees as permitted by law.


3. All other provisions of the subject Ordinance and prior amendments that are not specifically amended or altered herein shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.


4. Any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with this amended ordinance is and shall be repealed in so far as the same conflicts with this amended ordinance.


The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the 3rd day of May, 2011.


